Where is the 2016 13th Annual German Bierfest?

It is conveniently located at Woodruff Park in downtown Atlanta, near the intersection of Peachtree and Marietta Street. The address is 91 Peachtree St. NE, Atlanta, GA 30303.

Can I take MARTA to the festival?

Yes, MARTA is the preferred way to get to the German Bierfest. Five Points station is the closest to Woodruff Park. From Five Points, take the Peachtree Street exit out of the station and turn left. Please visit MARTA's website for information on taking MARTA.

Are there parking options and what is the cost?

33 Hurt Plaza Parking Garage (\$6 for 2 hours, \$10 day max)

55 Park Place Parking Garage (\$4 for 2 hours, \$6 day max)

34 Broad Street Parking Garage (\$5 first hour, \$1 each additional hour up to 8 hours, \$15 day max)

The German Bierfest is not responsible for parking garage rate changes.

How much are tickets and what do they include?

Tickets include a commemorative glass and all the German beer you can safely consume. Tickets are available online for \$35 in advance, and \$40 day of show. Designated Driver tickets can be purchased in advance or at the door for \$10.

How do I purchase single or group tickets?

Tickets can be purchased from FreshTix.com All event ticketing details and a link to purchase tickets can be found on the event website at www.germanbierfest.com. You can also pre-purchase tickets via phone by calling 678-701-6114. You can purchase tickets the day of the event at the box office located at the corner of Peachtree and Edgewood. The box office will open one hour before the event at 1pm.

Does a child need a ticket?

Everyone 16 and up needs a ticket to enter. Please find complete details on our website regarding General Admission and Designated Driver tickets.

What if I buy a ticket and cannot attend or lose my ticket?

There are no refunds or exchanges available. The 13th Annual German Bierfest is not responsible for lost or stolen tickets.

What forms of ID do you accept?

A current driver's license with photo from any state.

A current passport.

A DMV identification card.

A military card.*

*Please note that the state identification card and/or the military card must bear a picture of the person, the person's name, address, date of birth, a physical description, and the signature of the person.

May I bring my own food and beverage?

Sorry, but NO outside food or beverages may be brought into Woodruff Park during the festival. Thanks for your cooperation.

Can I bring my dog or pet to the event?

Sorry, unfortunately no pets are allowed due to City of Atlanta restrictions concerning outdoor festivals and events.

Are there concessions on-site?

Yes, our food vendors will have concession areas located in the park that offer authentic, traditional German specialties for purchase.

Are there ATMs at the festival?

Yes, there will be ATMs located in Woodruff Park for your convenience.

What is not permitted on the lawn of the event?

No. Woodruff Park is a city owned venue, and in accordance to law, smoking is not permitted in the venue.

Is drinking allowed outside the venue?

No, drinking alcohol is not allowed outside the venue perimeters or in any parking lots.

What time does the festival typically conclude?

The festival ends promptly at 7pm. Last call is at 6:45pm.
